Requirements:

Applicants must have been employed as a full-time law enforcement officer with a civilian law enforcement agency within the last 24 months and must have been employed a minimum of 12 months. Applicants must have graduated from the Basic Law Enforcement Academy and completed probation and possess a basic certification from CJTC. Officers with certifications from outside of Washington State must successfully complete the CJTC Equivalent Academy. Signing bonus is based on years of service, training, qualifications, instructor certifications and specialty assignments from previous employer.
